Dear Partner in Christ,

We greet you in Jesus' precious name. This Newsletter contains: (1) The relocation of Koko Children's Village and (2) the graduation of Pastor Liberty from Knox Theological Seminary.

As you were informed in our February Newsletter regarding the relocation of Koko Children's Village, some progress has been made. We took the children to another rented facility temporarily for two months (April & May) to enable us complete the first phase of their project. The Landlord refused to give us any more grace period because his property has been leased to someone for more than what were paying. However, pray for these children so that they will adjust to this transitional period. They are, at present, closer to their property. The next development is their schooling. They were closer to our Christian School and used to walk to school daily. But now, they are very far from the school. We have arranged with the school's administration to assign three teachers to them. But we are paying transportation for those who are in the junior and senior high divisions daily to school. It is our prayer that, *with your help*, we will complete their building even before the end of the two months.

We wish to announce the graduation of Pastor Liberty from Knox Theological Seminary with a Master of Divinity. The graduation will be held at the Coral Ridge Presbyterian Church (CRPC), 5555 North Federal Highway, Fort Lauderdale, Florida on Friday, May 16, 2008 at 7:00p.m.; reception follows at 8:00 p.m., in the Kennedy Fellowship Hall. You are invited to celebrate this joyous occasion with us.

Esther and I have decided to only receive congratulatory cards. In lieu of gifts, we would appreciate that you donate the value of the gift to your church as a *thanksgiving offering to God for what He has done for us*. Though we need gifts, but we strongly feel that God, who provided the scholarship through Knox for the training, *must receive the gifts*.
