Dear Partners in Christ:

With immense joy, we are grateful to God for His continual blessings upon this ministry even in this tight economy. In spite of the cut-back in our support by some of our partners and friends due to the prevailing financial constraint, the Lord continues to open other doors for his work. The following are updates of what God is doing as a result of your prayers:

First, Great News: We are pleased to announce to our partners and friends about what God is doing through Pastor Sherry Colby of the Victory Worship Center. The church has approved to commit for one year (August 2010-August 2011) to raise \$28,000 for this Ministry. This pledge is intended to alleviate the serious financial pressure affecting the ministry and to allow me smoothly complete my dissertation this year. Pray that the Lord will provide this amount through the Church.

Second, academic years 2010-2011 will commence during the first week of September 2010. We are praying and preparing for the orphans for the reopening of school. We need new uniforms for 48 of the orphans at \$35.00 per students and sneakers for 75 of them at \$15.00 each. There is no need for school supplies because a non-profit organization in Liberia donated it to the children for this semester, Praise God!

Third, September is our prayer month. Our churches in Liberia including friends in the United States join us for 21 days fast and prayer beginning September 1st. Pray with us, and if possible, you can join this time of consecration in intensive prayer.
